## **Scoring**

In determining the quiz results, simply tally the number of answers you gave for each Personality type. If you, for instance, have nineteen Visionary results and only a few answers in other categories, then you have extremely strong Visionary tendencies. If most of your answers fall into two categories, then you are probably a hybrid of those two types and will most likely feel allied with both. It is not unusual, however, for an individual's answers to be almost evenly scattered between three or four categories: this simply means that you have a broad range of impulses and tendencies, and various facets of your character are sympathetic with various types. ## The answers
